

Anti-U1 snRNP C (U1C) antibody, rat monoclonal (4H12)

70-400 100 µg

The **spliceosomal U1C protein** is critical to the initiation and regulation of precursor messenger RNA (pre-mRNA) splicing, as part of the U1 small nuclear ribonucleoprotein particle (**snRNP**). U1C is needed for efficient complex formation of U1 snRNP with a 5' splice site.

The antibody was produced from the hybridoma cultured in serum-free medium and purified under mild conditions by propriety chromatography processes.

Applications

1. Western blotting 2. Immunocytochemistry 3. Immunohistochemistry (frozen section)
4. ELISA Other applications are not tested.

Immunogen: Recombinant GST-fused mouse U1C (full length)

Isotype: Rat IgG 2a kappa

Form: Purified monoclonal antibody (IgG) 1mg/ml in PBS, 50% glycerol, filter-sterilized

Specificity: Specific to human, simian, and mouse U1C. Other species are not tested.

Storage: -20°C (long period, -70°C)

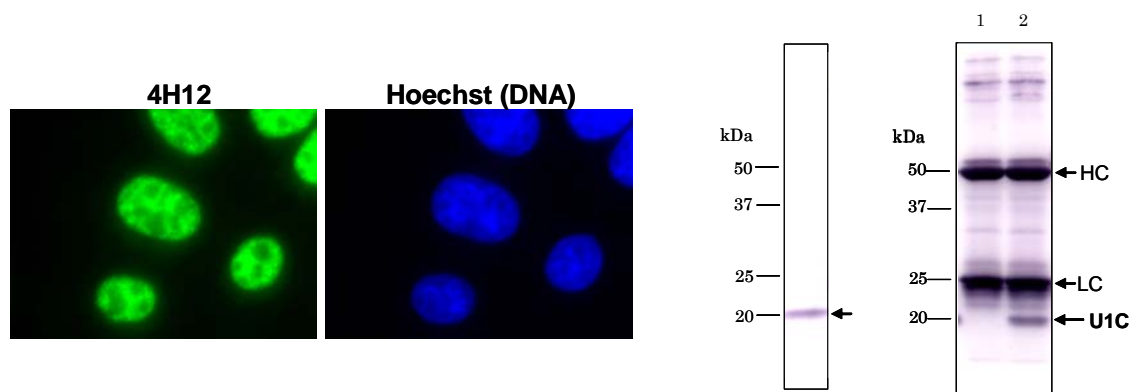


Fig.1 Immunofluorescent staining of L929 (mouse) cells with antibody 4H12.
